Boarding fees will be assessed as outlined in item III. NOTE: Fee includes microchip and core vaccines (excludes rabies vaccine).	
	Option 2 - When unaltered animals are impounded and reclaimed by the owner, the owner can opt to pay the intact animal reclaim fee and take their animal to a vet of their choice for spay/neuter within 30 days of reclaim. The owner must then submit a request for the difference of Intact animal reclaim fee and the sterilized intact fee (current difference \$50). Boarding fees will be assessed as outlined in item III.
