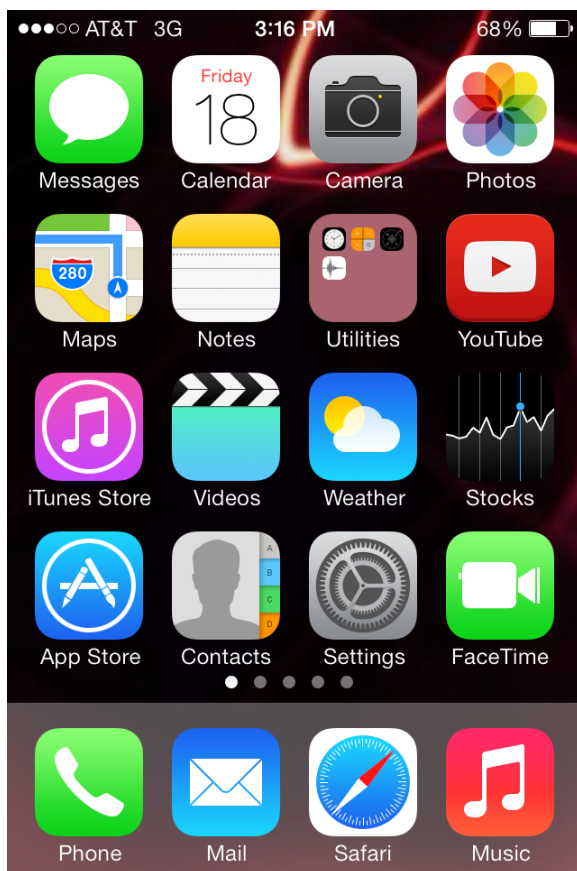
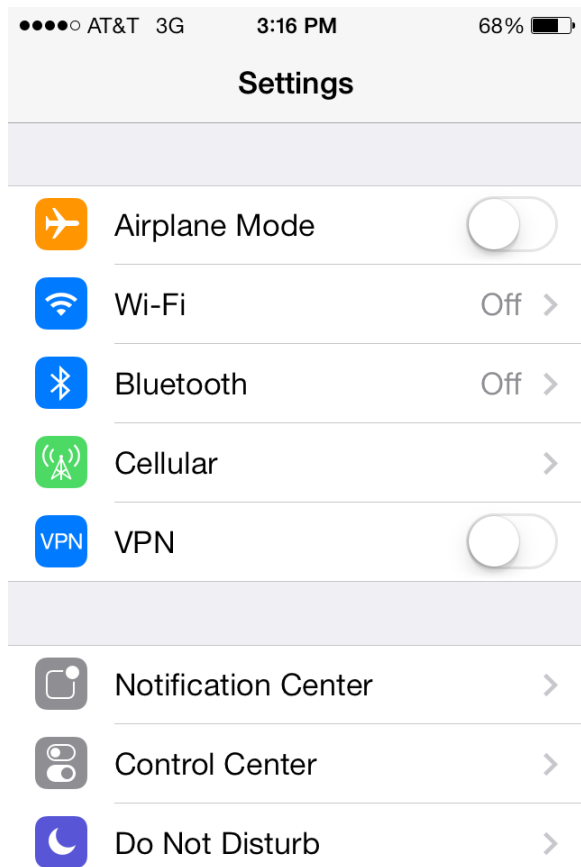


Connecting to new Cisco wireless infrastructure from an iPhone running IOS 7

Start on the main screen and press the settings icon:



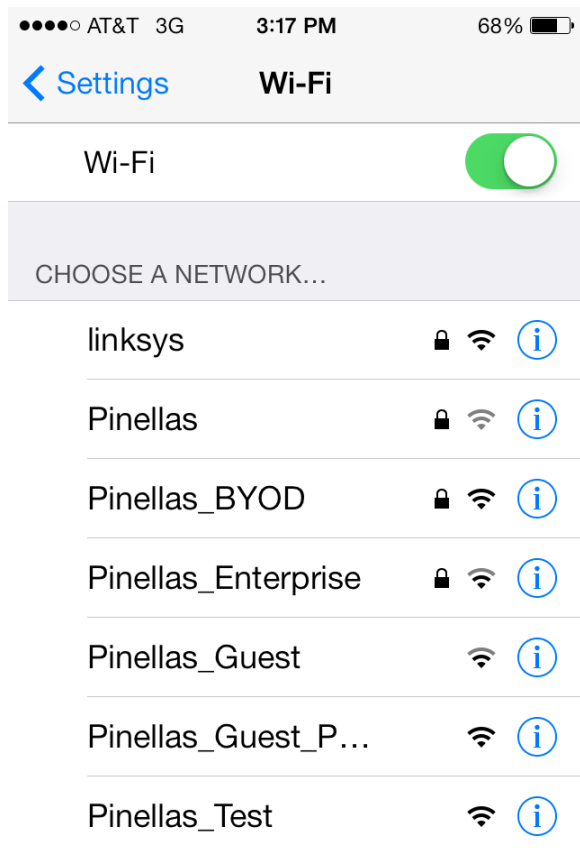
Next, touch the Wi-Fi entry:



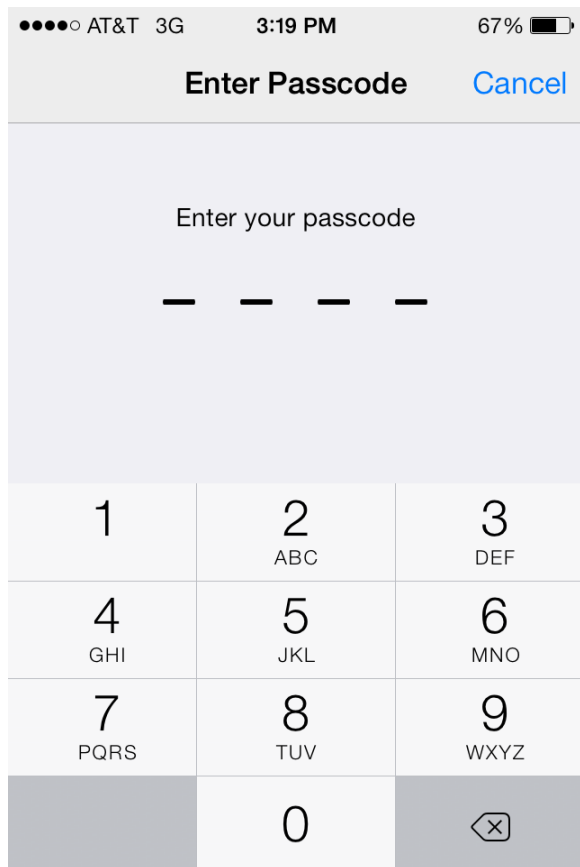
“Swipe” the Wi-Fi button to the right to enable it:



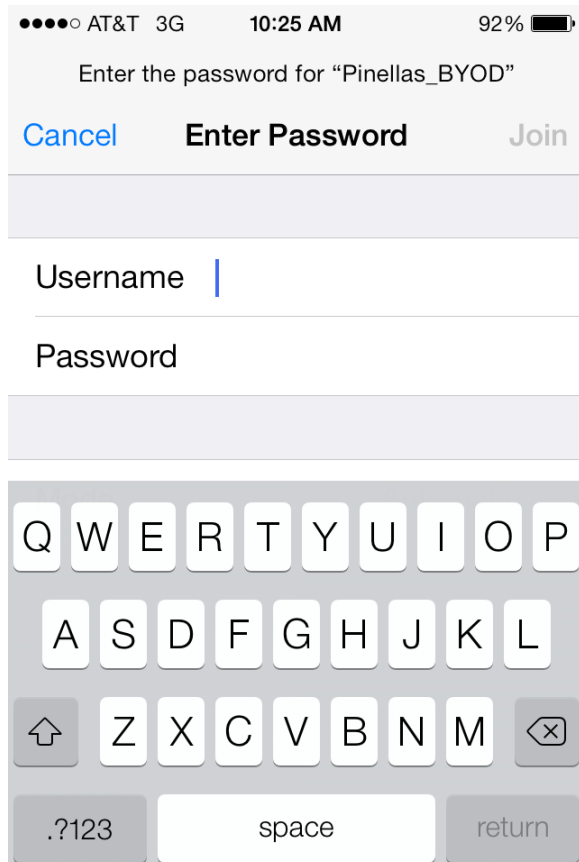
After doing this, all of the available wireless network that the device “sees” will be displayed. Select “Pinellas_BYOD”:



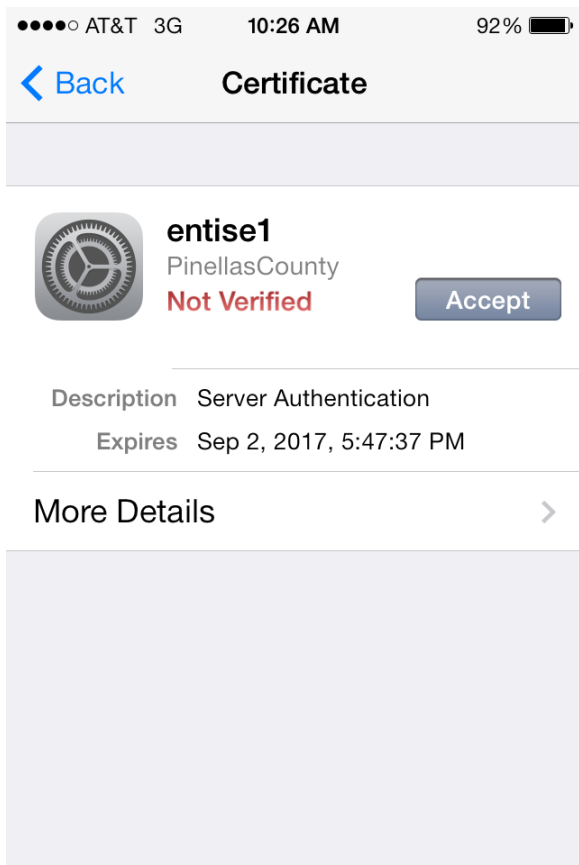
At this point, you *may* be asked to enter your passcode if you have this feature enabled:



After a short time, a request to enter your credentials will appear. Enter your Username and Password, and press the “Join” entry near the top right of the screen.



After a short time, the screen below will appear that will provide you with your certificate. Select "accept" to do this:
