

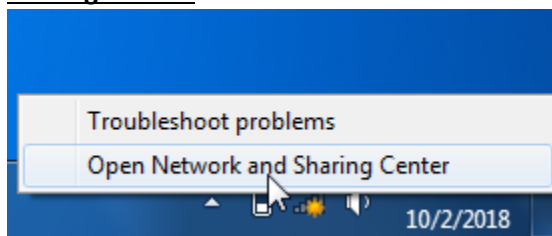
Wireless How-to for Windows 7 Pinellas Enterprise

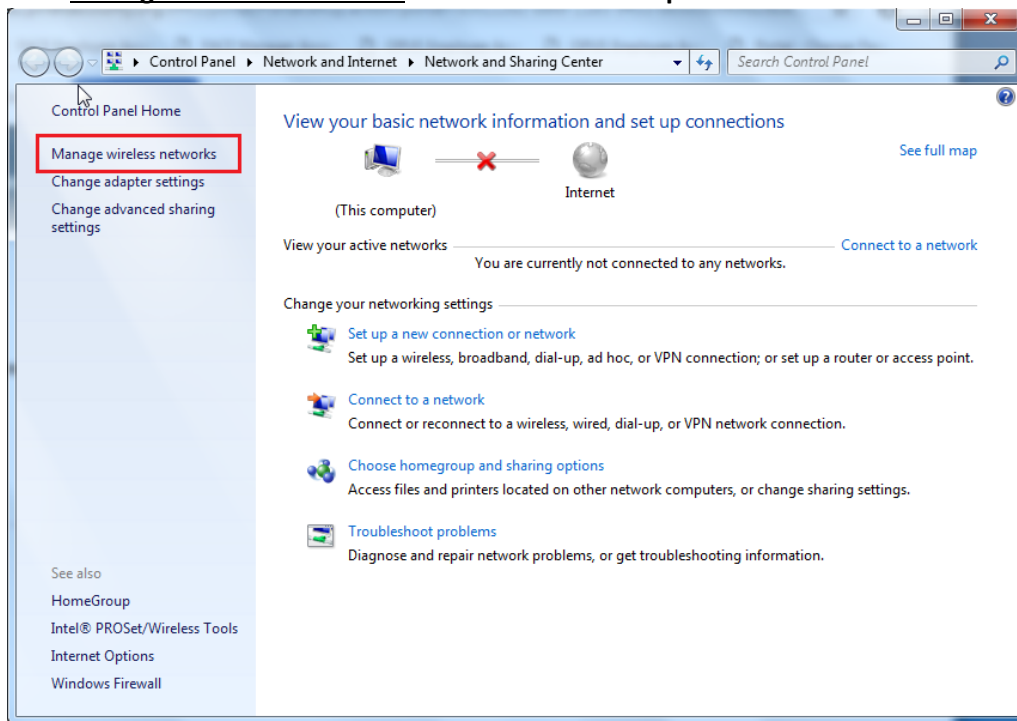
The following procedure is a one-time configuration. This process will install a client certificate on your computer and auto-configure your wireless profile.

If this is the first time you have onboarded to the county Enterprise Wireless Network, skip to step 5.

1. **Right-click the Wireless Icon on the taskbar near the clock and select Open Network and Sharing Center.**



2. **Click Manage Wireless Networks in the window that opens.**



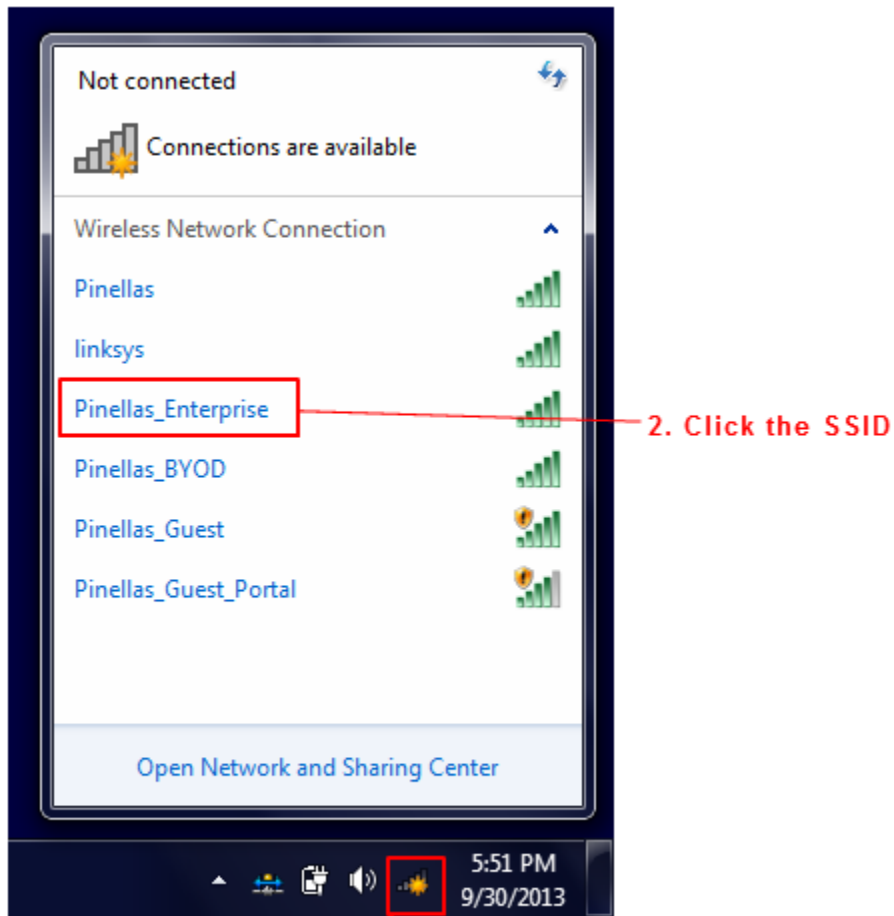
3. Select Pinellas_Enterprise and then click Remove.

Manage wireless networks that use (Wireless Network Connection)

Windows tries to connect to these networks in the order listed below.

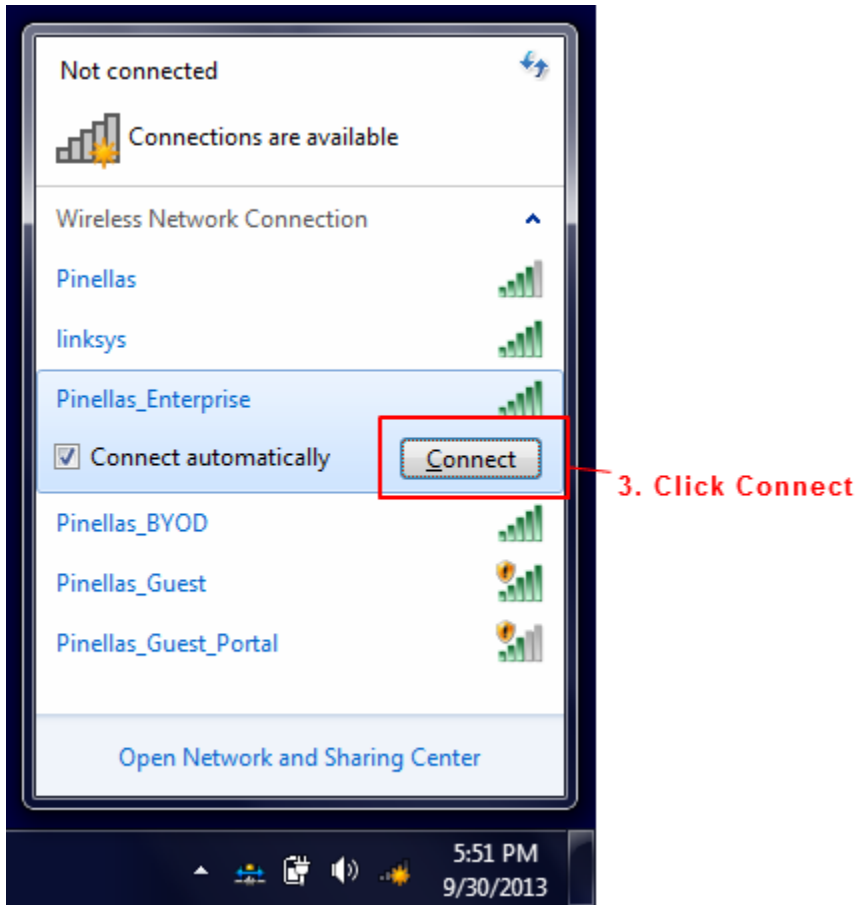


4. Click OK and then close the Network and Sharing Center window.
5. Click the wireless icon on your taskbar.
6. Click the Pinellas_Enterprise SSID

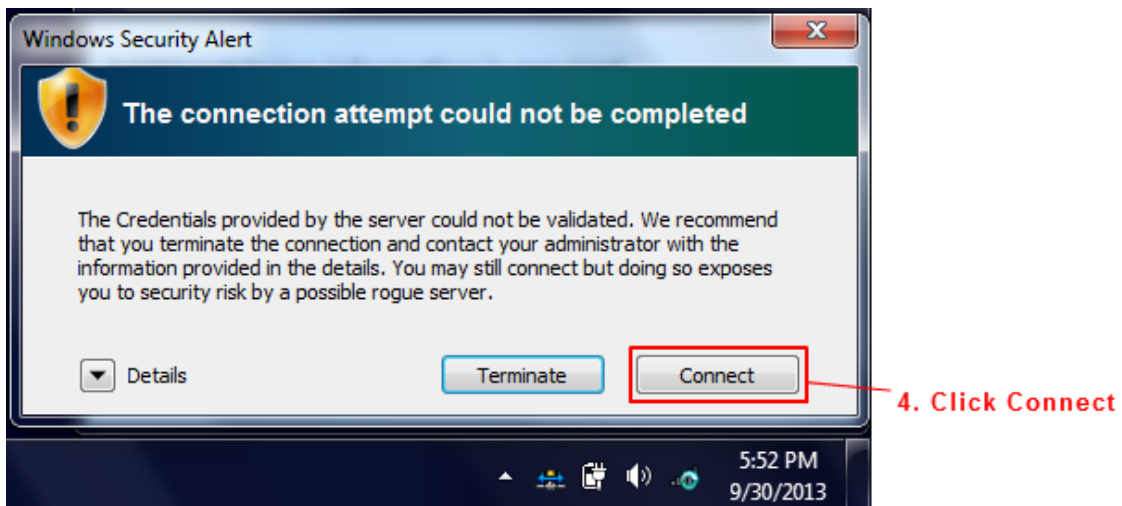


1. Click the wireless icon

7. Click the Connect button.



8. Click the Connect button for this security alert. This may not occur for all users.

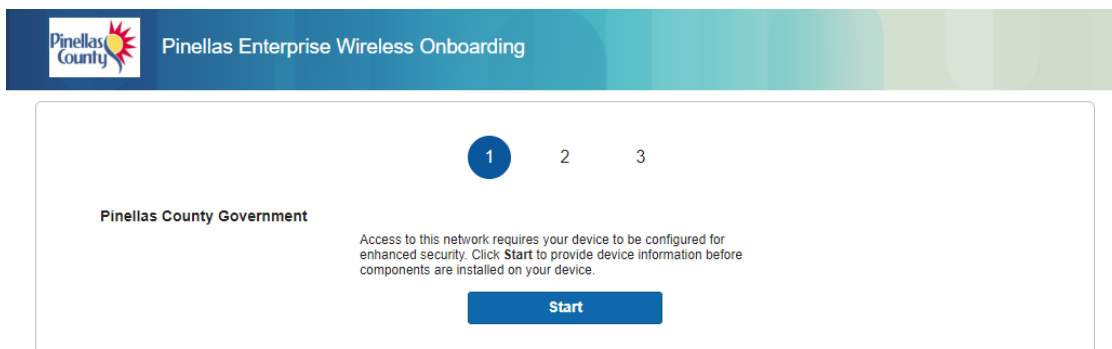


9. (Optional) Clicking on the wireless icon will show you're connected. You're not fully connected yet. Please continue.



1. Click the wireless icon.
Notice the Connected status above.

10. Now launch Internet Explorer and browse to any website. You will be redirected to the following dialog and click Start.
*If the redirect fails and you do not see the webpage below, enter <http://1.1.1.1> into the address field of your browser.



11. Enter your user ID as the Device Name and a simple description of the device you are connecting with as a description.

12. Click the Continue button.

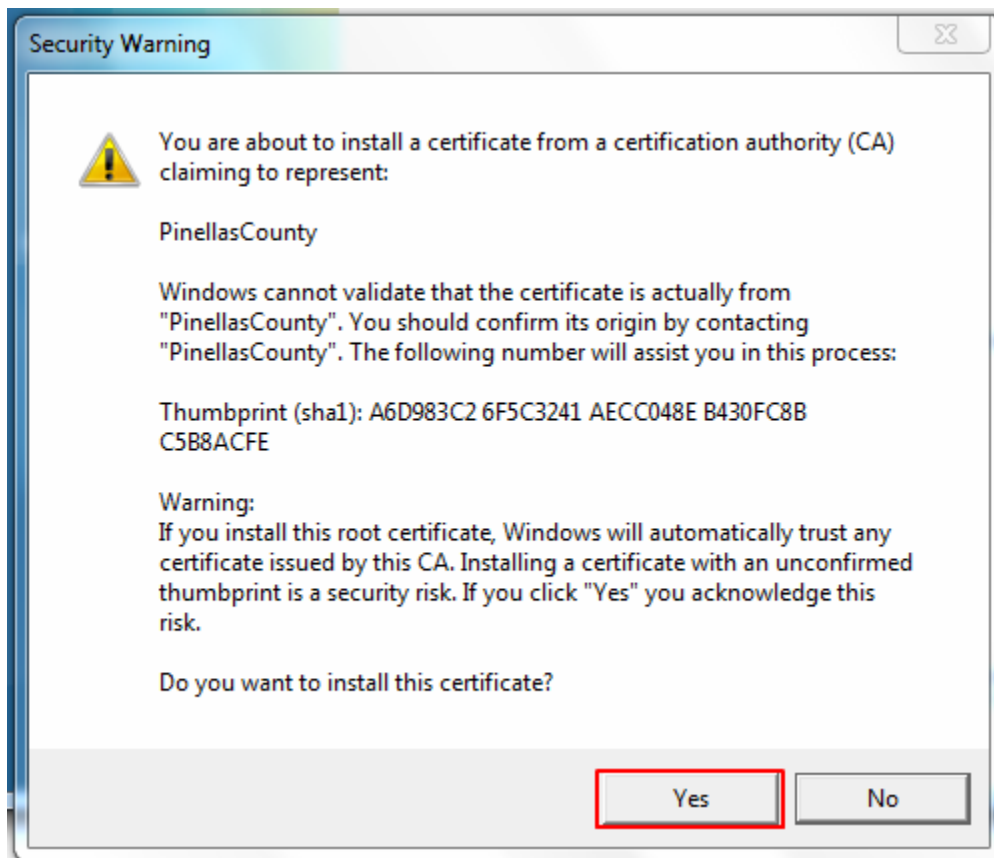
