
3. Please select the Policies tab prior to making reservations to read the campground rules and cancellation policies before making any reservations

Area-1 Includes Sites-1-85 are designated for tent, vans and pop-up campers under 16' in length


5. Once you have found the site you would like to reserve, **Click your mouse on that site grid**.





Rental of Fort De Soto Campground Site 005 - Waterfront 05/18/2020 1p-05/25/2020 11a (Camp Fee Waterfront Standard Sites 1-85)

- A \$5 fee will be assessed for any changes or cancellations made to any reservation.
- . Cancellations initiated within the 48hr window will be assessed a 1 night penalty in addition to \$5 cancellation fee.
- Requests for refunds or changes to your reservation must be submitted 48 hours prior to your reservation check-in (BY 1pm).
- From January through April, there is a 14 night maximum for any camp stay. After that you must vacate the campground for a 30day period before being able to return.
- From May through December, occupancy may be extended for an additional 14 nights depending upon availability of campsites at the discretion of the Resident Park Manager.
- Pets are only permitted in Area 2 and must be on a leash and supervised at all times.
- · Gas-powered golf carts are not permitted.
- You may not utilize the space outside of the shell-bed area of your campsite for any camping or parking.
- . There is no swimming from the campground area.
- Ground fires (campfires) must be above ground and self contained. Fire is permitted only in designated locations. No fires are
- Frying of any kind is prohibited, including but not limited to turkey fryers, deep fat fryers, skillets, and electric frying pan.
- · Alcohol is not permitted.
- We do not permit the use of gasoline-powered generators
- You may not camp or park a vehicle in any site other than your own.
- · Parking is allowed in designated areas only and violators will be ticketed.
- The removal, damage, or defacement of trees, shrubs, or other plants is prohibited.
- The feeding of any wildlife (raccoons, squirrels, birds, etc.) is prohibited.
- You may not remove picnic tables from the original camp site.
- We do not permit organized group camping.
- . Non-disposal of all trash will result in a fine


