Pinellas County has prepared a [Second Substantial Amendment to the FY2019 Annual Action Plan](#) (Second Amendment) to enable the County to receive and administer \$2,401,815 in Community Development Block Grant – Coronavirus Response Round 3 (CDBG-CV3) funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to prepare, prevent and respond to the COVID-19 Pandemic, made available through the Coronavirus AID, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES Act).

Availability for Viewing

The draft of the Second Amendment is available for viewing and public comment from **March 18 to March 22, 2021**. Due to the continued locally declared state of emergency in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the draft of the Second Amendment will be available on the Pinellas County website at www.pinellascounty.org/community.
