

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING WITH VIRTUAL PARTICIPATION OPTION
HOME-ARP ALLOCATION PLAN
NOVEMBER 9, 2022**

Pinellas County is in the process of preparing its HOME-ARP Allocation Plan to allocate federal funding to eligible activities. The Pinellas County HOME Consortium anticipates a total HOME-ARP funding allocation of \$4,794,571.

Eligible activities under the HOME-ARP program include Supportive Services, Non-Congregate Shelter, Tenant-Based Rental Assistance (TBRA), Affordable Rental Housing, and Non-Profit Operating and Capacity Building. Qualifying populations include persons experiencing homelessness, those at risk of homelessness, those fleeing or attempting to flee violence or human trafficking, veterans, and other persons at greatest risk of housing instability.

The public hearing will provide an opportunity to view and provide comments on the proposed Pinellas County HOME-ARP Allocation Plan. The following activities and funding have been identified as the greatest needs of the qualifying populations through the County’s consultation with agencies and service providers serving the qualifying populations in Pinellas County.
