

**Housing Finance Authority – TEFRA Hearing
Pinellas County
December 6, 2022**

The Housing Finance Authority of Pinellas County (HFA) (as created by the Code of Ordinances of Pinellas County, Section 2-386) met in special session to conduct a public hearing at 8:30 AM on this date at the HFA's office located at 450 Carillon Parkway, Suite 105, St. Petersburg, Florida 33716.

PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER PROPOSED ISSUANCE BY THE HOUSING FINANCE AUTHORITY OF PINELLAS COUNTY OF ITS MULTIFAMILY HOUSING REVENUE BONDS (RIVERSIDE APARTMENTS), IN AN AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF NOT TO EXCEED \$39,000,000 IN ONE OR MORE INSTALLMENTS OR SERIES.

Pursuant to notice published on the HFA's website on November 17, 2022, as evidenced by affidavit of publication, a public hearing was held for the purpose of receiving comments and hearing discussion concerning the proposed issuance of Multifamily Housing Revenue Bonds, in an aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$39,000,000 in one or more series pursuant to a plan of finance, over a period of time exceeding one year, but not longer than permitted by such Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

Ms. Driver indicated that proceeds of the Bonds will be used to finance the acquisition and rehabilitation of a 304 unit multifamily rental housing facility for persons or families of moderate, middle or lesser income with the City of Tarpon Springs, Pinellas County, which is located at 1589 Starlight Cove, Tarpon Springs, Florida, which will initially be owned and operated by OK Riverside LLC, a Florida limited liability company, or its affiliate.

No one appeared in response to Ms. Driver's call for persons wishing to be heard in favor of or in opposition to the proposed bond issuance; whereupon, she closed the public hearing.
