COUNSELING SERVICES


- 6 counseling sessions, per household member, per issue, per year on issues such as anxiety, relationship problems, depression, stress or substance use

CONSULTATIONS

- Legal: 30 minutes with an attorney, face-to-face or by phone
- Financial: 30 minutes with a qualified specialist by phone
- Identity theft: 60 minutes with a fraud resolution specialist by phone

- Parenting: childcare, after school programs, adoption, and more
- Eldercare: home health agencies, assisted living facilities, recreational programs and long-distance caregiving
- Pet care: veterinarians, pet sitting, obedience training
