Summary of Completed Goals/Objectives Contained within CRA Plan

The ultimate goal for the Lealman Community Redevelopment Area is for it to reduce blight and improve the overall quality of life for residents in the community. To achieve this goal, the CRA Plan outlines nine objectives and strategies addressing the following disciplines: (1) Economic Development and Innovation, (2) Commercial, (3) Housing, (4) Infrastructure and Transportation, (5) Urban Form, (6) Health Community, (7) Sustainability, (8) Branding, Marketing and Promotion, and (9) Funding, Financing and Management. While work to achieve the redevelopment goal is ongoing, progress was made using increment revenue in the areas identified below. CRA staff also coordinated approximately \$1.67 million of investment made by Pinellas County utilizing non-increment funds for the projects identified below, all of which advance various CRA Plan objectives and strategies.
