Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 1:32pm by Jason Malpass, Vice Chair, in the absence of the Chair.

Citizens to be Heard

The opportunity was offered for citizens to make comments. There were two citizens attending.

- Greta Finney talked about a proposal for a map-based one stop shop for Election Management. She
 expressed a need to simplify the current tools provided by GIS and Supervisor of Elections for the
 Citizens, volunteers, outreach organizations and local media. Since the County is on the ESRI platform,
 she mentioned that Esri has an Election Management Hub solution available that could provide the data
 in public facing maps and applications. Greta provided a power point presentation on the specifics of
 her suggestions.
- Polly thanked Greta for providing this information and reiterated the need for quick access for citizens.

In response, Committee Member and Supervisor of Elections Chief Deputy Marc Gillette, thanked both Greta and Polly for their suggestions on improvements. Marc mentioned that the Supervisor of Elections data is available on their website, but it currently is not map based. The Supervisor of Elections office is looking into these suggested products and may work to implement some of them after the 2024 Presidential Election in November.

Approval of Minutes

Jason Malpass asked for motion to approve the minutes for the December 7th, 2023, meeting. Motion to approve from Jeremy Waugh, seconded by Marc Gillette, all in favor. Minutes approved.

Working Group Presentation

Working Group Representation Updates

Jared Austin, Chair of the eGIS Working Group, gave an update on some primary and secondary member updates and that they have appointed a new Vice Chair, Scott Stillwell from Public Works.

Aerial & LiDAR Updates

Jamie Munro announced that the 2024 – 2029 Aerial Contract has been approved which is a 5-year contract for an anticipated annual charge of \$249,000. The vendor selected is GPI. The 2024 flight capture has been completed and the EagleView Early Access was just received and available, although a formal notice has not been sent out yet.

LiDAR status is ongoing with work with USGS to establish a formal agreement. It is anticipated that the formal agreement will go before the BCC sometime in May for approval. This means the County will likely have the LiDAR captured around the end of 2024 / start of 2025.

Esri Contract Renewal

Jamie indicated that BTS continues to work with Esri on the contract renewal. He had hoped to share more details; including cost but not much had changed since the December update. One thing that has changed is that it looks like the \$900,000 in ARPA funding to support GIS integration with the new Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) implementation project may still be available. So, BTS will pursue the purchase of Esri StreetMap Premium data licensing using ARPA funds and that may help offset increases to the larger Esri contract being negotiated. Jeremy Waugh asked if using the ARPA funds aligns with how they were granted. Bryan Zumwalt answered that the use of the ARPA funds had been approved and it's intended to use was to benefit CAD for PRIME as well as Safety and Emergency Services.

Large Technology Changes

Jamie went over the projects currently being worked on by the eGIS Team, 4 of which are part of the larger technology changes that will be happening this year. eGIS is looking into downsizing the 100+ servers that are currently being maintained with DEV/TEST/PROD to move some to the cloud (AWS) and ArcGIS Online.

- SaaS (Software as a Service) First Approach this is where we will be moving the Enterprise Published data (PGIS) to ArcGIS Online, along with other portal hosted layers and applications.
- Branch Versioning this is where the editing data (EGIS) will be moved to the cloud (AWS) and workflows using Branch Versioning (vs Traditional Versioning) will be set up.
- Experience Builder is the new platform application from Esri. The current Esri Web AppBuilder platform is being deprecated and there is a push to get the existing applications moved to Experience Builder. The first step to provide the departments templates to aide the process of moving from the old Web AppBuilder platform to the new Experience Builder platform.

April Klimkoski then gave a demonstration of the draft of the new Know Your Zone application using Experience Builder showing new functionality and showing how the application looks on a mobile phone.

Open Discussion

Jamie quickly went over the upcoming conferences for the year. It was asked about digital access to the Dev Summit which costs \$99, and the eGIS team indicated they would follow up.

Bryan Zumwalt mentioned that the Esri contract renewal was one of two large contracts that BTS is working on this year. BTS is trying to keep the Esri contract under \$1,000,000.

Jamie went over the upcoming 2024 Steering Committee meetings will be June 6th, September 5th, and December 5th. Also, noted the Working Group meetings were moved to the last Thursday of each month.

Adjournment

Meeting adjourned at 2:23pm. Marc Gillette motioned to adjourn; Jeremy Waugh seconded.




