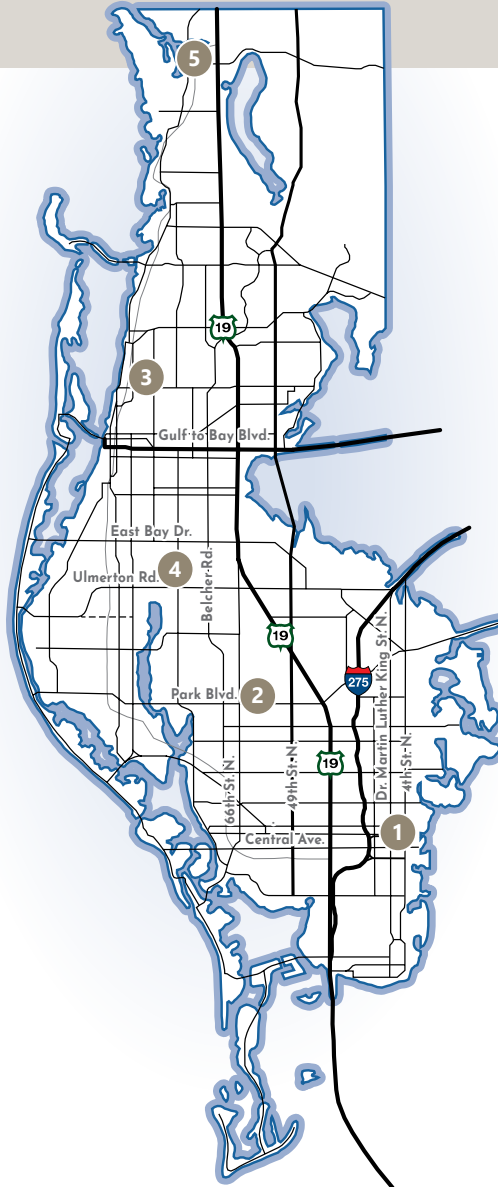

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The Pinellas County Health Program provides free quality health care services

The program is available to low-income, uninsured residents ages 18 to 64 who are not eligible for Medicaid, Medicare, or other health programs. Enrolled participants receive services in a medical home at one of five participating Florida Health Department of Pinellas County locations.



The Program Covers:

- Primary care physician visits
- Referrals to specialty physicians and providers
- Wellness and prevention services, including annual physicals and nutrition education
- Mental health and substance use services
- Chronic disease management
- Cancer screening
- Pharmacy services
- Preventive dental services
- Laboratory services
- Referral services for disability assistance and behavioral health

Required Paperwork:

Social Security card and one other form of ID, such as:

- Birth certificate
- Florida or Student ID
- U.S. Passport
- Driver's license

Proof of Pinellas County residency, such as:

- Employment record
- Vehicle registration or title
- Pay stub
- Current utility bill

Proof of citizenship or immigration if born outside the United States, such as:

- U.S. Passport
- U.S. Naturalization documents
- Permanent Resident Card
- Bank Statements
- CashApp/PayPal/Venmo, etc.

Proof of income

- Award letters from Social Security Administration or Veterans Administration
- Pay stubs/Self-employment records
- Child support/Alimony
- Workers' compensation

A Case Manager will discuss additional documents required if needed.
