**CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL**

Dr. Matt Nelson called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. Roll call was taken, and Lynn Abbott determined that a quorum was present. There were ten (10) voting members in attendance.

**MINUTES OF THE SEPTEMBER 18, 2025 MEETING – APPROVED**

Upon presentation by Dr. Nelson, Dr. Matthew Smith moved, seconded by Dr. Roberto Bellini and carried unanimously, that the minutes of the September 18, 2025 EMS Medical Control Board meeting be approved.

## **RECOGNITION OF DR. JOSEPH NAMEY – Craig Hare**

Craig Hare announced that Dr. Joseph Namey is retiring after 30 years with the Medical Control Board (MCB) and the Pinellas County Community; whereupon, Mr. Hare presented Dr. Namey with a plaque and, with input by Dr. Jameson, recognized his dedication and service to the MCB, noting his instrumental support to the EMS and Largo Hospital Academic Program, for years he had a team of residents and physicians that provided on-site ACLA training in Pinellas and Hillsborough Counties. Dr. Namey thanked the Board for its support over the years.

## **CITIZENS TO BE HEARD**

Glenn Davis, eTMS Florida, presented information on EEG-guided Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation (ETMS) for PTSD, anxiety, sleep issues or depression and highlighted benefits for First Responders.

## **CLINICAL UPDATES – DR. JAMESON**

Dr. Jameson displayed documents titled *2025 Medical Operations Manual Protocol Updates Executive Summary, Volume 1 Clinical Operating Guidelines (Effective Quarter 1 – 2026)*, and *Volume 1 Clinical Operating Guidelines (Effective Quarter 2 – 2026)* and provided the following clinical updates:

### **a. Approval Items**

- **Protocols to go-live Q1 2026 - APPROVED**
  - CP14 Transcutaneous Pacing – Stryker LifePack15
  - CP18 Wound Packing – Hemostatic Gauze and Emergency Trauma Dressing

Dr. Jameson referred to the Executive Summary and pages 9 through 14 of the protocol packet and provided information regarding the updates to the *CP14 Transcutaneous Pacing – Stryker LifePack15* protocol.

Referring to the Executive Summary and pages 15 and 16 of the protocol packet, Dr. Jameson presented an outline of the changes to the *CP18 Wound Packing – Hemostatic Gauze and Emergency Trauma Dressing* protocol.

Following discussion, Dr. Roberto Bellini moved, seconded by Nancy Hopkins, that the updates to *CP14 Transcutaneous Pacing – Stryker LifePack15* and *CP18 Wound Packing – Hemostatic Gauze and Emergency Trauma Dressing* protocols be approved. Upon call for the vote, the motions were approved unanimously.

- **Protocols to go-live Q2/3 2026 - APPROVED**
  - CS1 – Definition of a Patient (updated language from previous meeting approval)
  - CS16 - DNRO/MOLST/POLST
  - P6 – Pediatric Bradycardia (updated language from previous meeting approval)
  - CP27- Normal Childbirth Procedure
  - CP24 - Patient Restraint for Transport

Dr. Jameson referred to the Executive Summary and pages 17 through 29 of the protocol packet and summarized the updates to the CS1 – Definition of a Patient (updated language from previous meeting approval), CS16 - DNRO/MOLST/POLST, P6 – Pediatric Bradycardia (updated language from previous meeting approval), CP27- Normal Childbirth Procedure, and CP24 - Patient Restraint for Transport protocols.

Following discussion, Dr. Roberto Bellini moved, seconded by Dr. Brian Charity, that the updates to the CS1 – Definition of a Patient (updated language from previous meeting approval), CS16 - DNRO/MOLST/POLST, P6 – Pediatric Bradycardia (updated language from previous meeting approval), CP27- Normal Childbirth Procedure, and CP24 - Patient Restraint for Transport protocols be approved. Upon call for the vote, the motion was approved unanimously.

**b. Report/Discussion Items**

- **Whole Blood Rollout Plan Update**

Dr. Jameson provided background information regarding the Critical Care Transport Team and its implementation of the Whole Blood Rollout Plan to the field, noting that the protocol framework was discussed at the September 18, 2025 MCB meeting. OneBlood and Bayfront are in logistics discussions for rollout by Q2 2026.

- **CCT Equipment Updates**

Jazmin Soloman, with input by Dr. Jameson and Craig Hare, conducted a presentation of the following new equipment:

- External Pacemaker
- GlideScope Go2
- Fetal Monitor

**ACQUISITION OF PARAMEDICS LOGISTICS FLORIDA**

Craig Hare provided an overview of the acquisition of Paramedics Logistics Florida by Grant Avenue Capital and discussed Pinellas County’s completed due diligence and recommended approval of the agreement, noting there will be no changes in the local management team, contract terms, labor agreement, or insurance.

Craig Hare provided an overview of the following highlights:

- AI Assist in ImageTrend, utilizing *voice to text* to read narrative on cases.
- Zoll Billing Pro contract signed; Ambulance Billing implementation planned for April 2026.
- Learning Management System (LMS) vendor evaluations being conducted.
- Peregrine software analytics integration for performance indicators and dashboards/reports.

Mr. Brent Burish requested that the issue of Sunstar's Pre-Authorization for the reimbursement of non-emergency ambulance transportation be delayed until March 2026, and lengthy discussion had regarding the implementation of Sunstar's Pre-Authorization requirement and working group to continue to meet and share information.
