PSCC Follow-Up: ICE Hold Clarifications

Responses to Questions Raised at the Previous Meeting

During the December 1, 2025, 4th quarter PSCC meeting, members requested clarification on how individuals with ICE or Border Patrol (BP) detainers are represented in the jail population data. The Sheriff's Office provided the following responses.

1. How are individuals with an ICE hold represented when they also have a current felony or misdemeanor charge?

Response:

- The ICE number reflected in the ADP represents individuals entering jail solely on an ICE courtesy detainer. These individuals do not have local charges and may remain in custody for up to 72 hours.
- If an individual has both a local charge and an ICE detainer, they are counted under the applicable local charge category (Pretrial Felony, Pretrial Misdemeanor, County Sentenced Felony, or County Sentenced Misdemeanor).
- If local charges are resolved and the individual remains in custody solely due to the ICE detainer, they are moved to the "Other" category, which includes ICE, U.S. Marshal, other counties, and other state holds.

2. Can the ICE / Border Patrol hold population be broken down further (e.g., ICE-only, BP-only, and by charge type)?

Response:

- The Sheriff's Office indicated that ICE-only and BP-only counts can be identified.
- Additional details, such as the number of individuals with felony or misdemeanor charges within these groups, would be possible but would require modifications to the current report.
- Further clarification is also needed to determine whether counts should reflect individuals held solely on the detainer or those who initially had local charges before the detainer remained as the only hold.

3. Can a version of the ADP be generated that excludes individuals with ICE or BP detainers?

Response:

- This request was deferred to the staff responsible for producing the ADP report, as the report is generated through the Sheriff's Office reporting process.

Note:

- All ICE statistics reflected in the ADP represent monthly averages, and any changes to reporting related to ICE statistics must be approved by the Sheriff's Office.

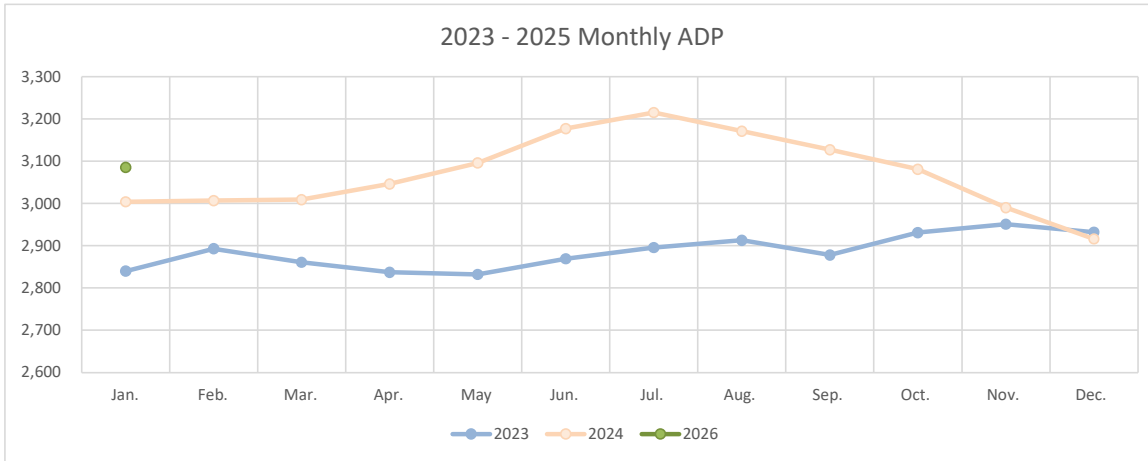

(Indicators Report – 2025 Year-End Overview)

- **Average Daily Population (ADP) continued trending upward** throughout 2025, increasing from 2,873 in January to 3,085 in December, maintaining levels above 3,000 in the latter half of the year. (Page 1–2)
- **Pretrial felonies** still make up most of the jail population, comprising about **61% of those in custody.** (Page 3)
- Overall **jail population grew from December 2024 to December 2025**, increasing from **2,916 to 3,085**, reflecting growth in multiple custody categories. (Page 4)
- **Pretrial misdemeanor and sentenced populations also grew during 2025**, contributing to the overall population increase. (Page 4)
- **Federal holds show notable changes**, including a significant increase in ICE / Border Patrol holds, which reached 577 individuals in December 2025 compared to 50 in December 2024. (Page 4)
- Individuals awaiting **treatment placement declined slightly**, while individuals awaiting transfer to **DOC or other facilities remained relatively stable.** (Page 4)
- VOP arrests remained steady overall, with all VOP arrests increasing slightly from 3,006 in 2024 to 3,082 in 2025. (Page 5)
- Juvenile Assessment Center (JAC) bookings totaled 2,481 for 2025, with bookings distributed relatively evenly across the year. (Page 7)

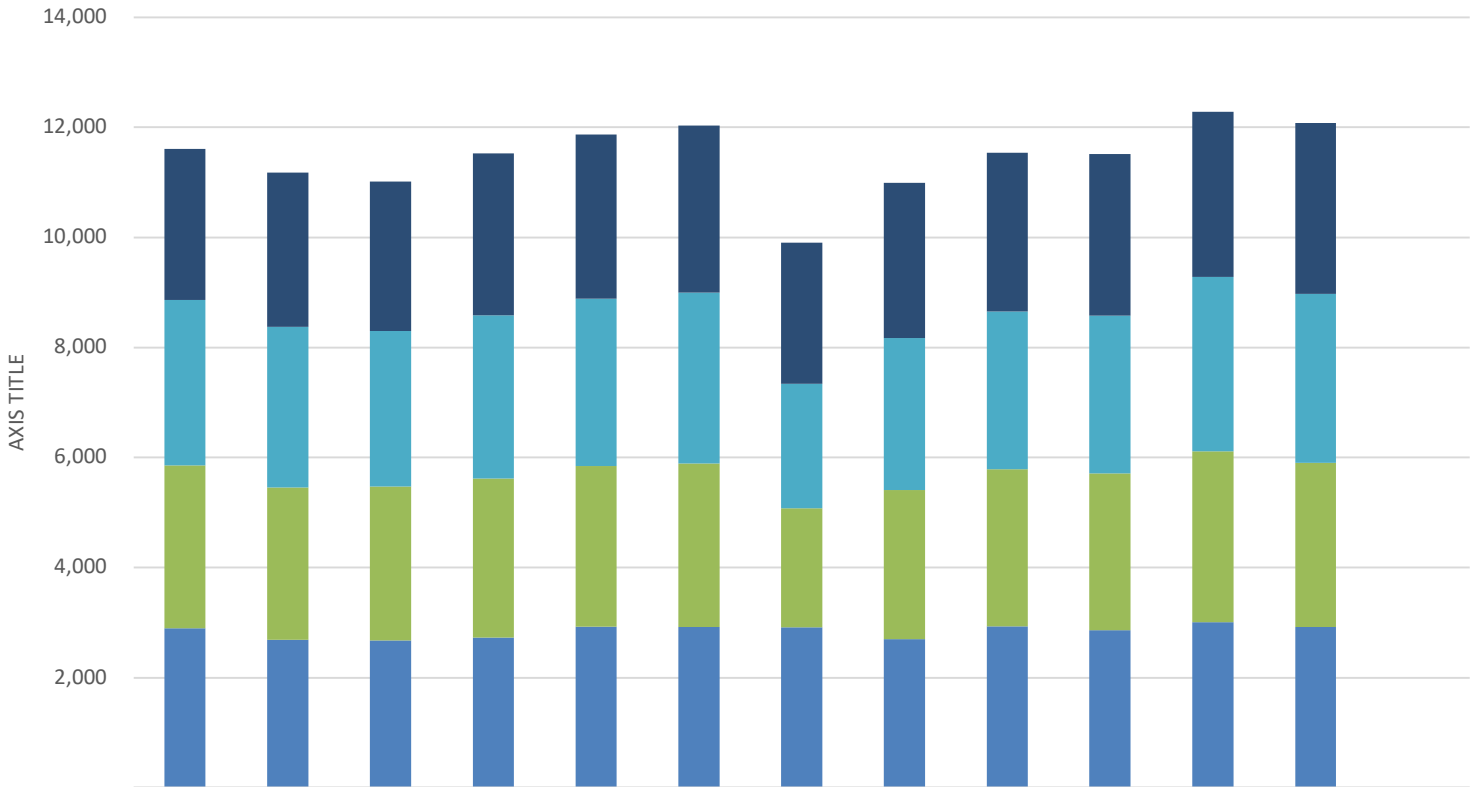

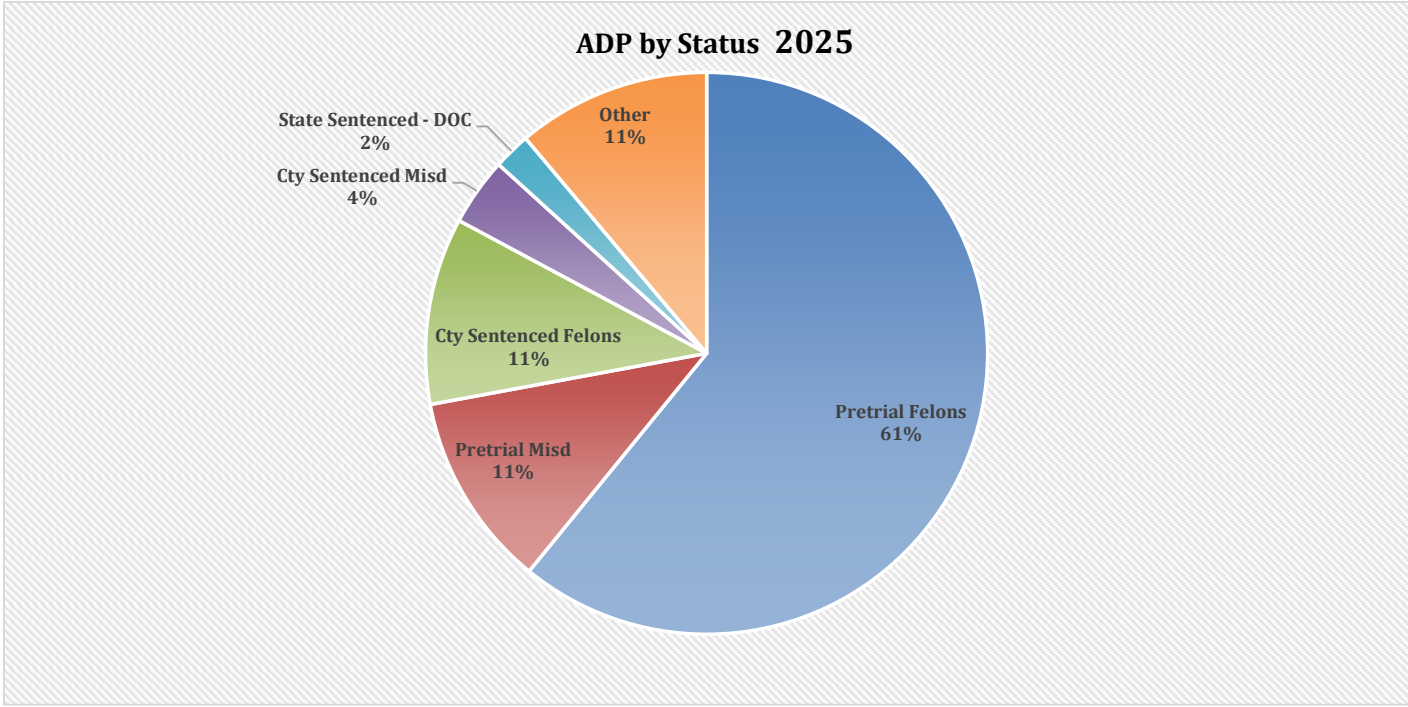
Pinellas County Jail ADP By Quarter (2014-2025)

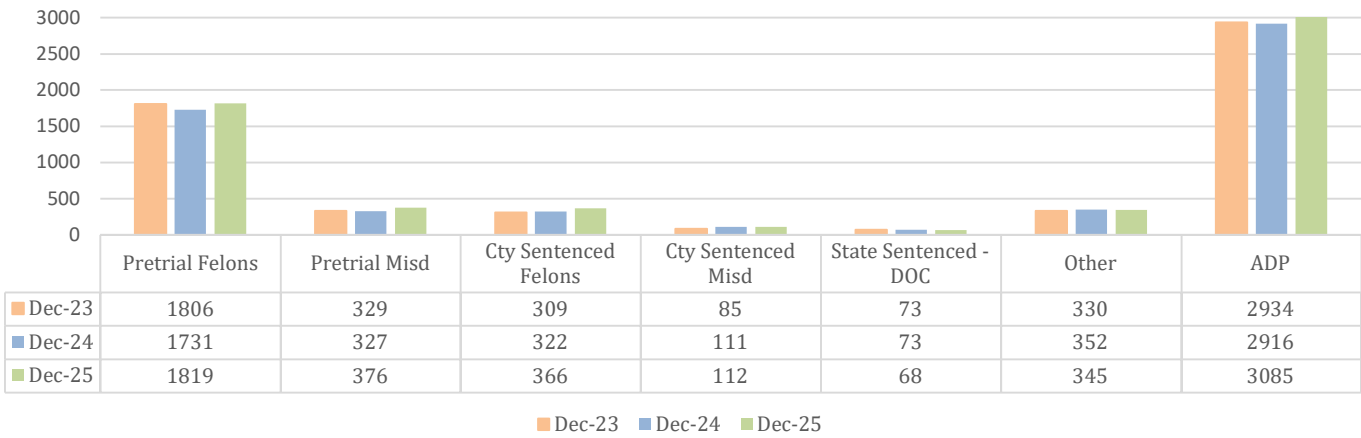

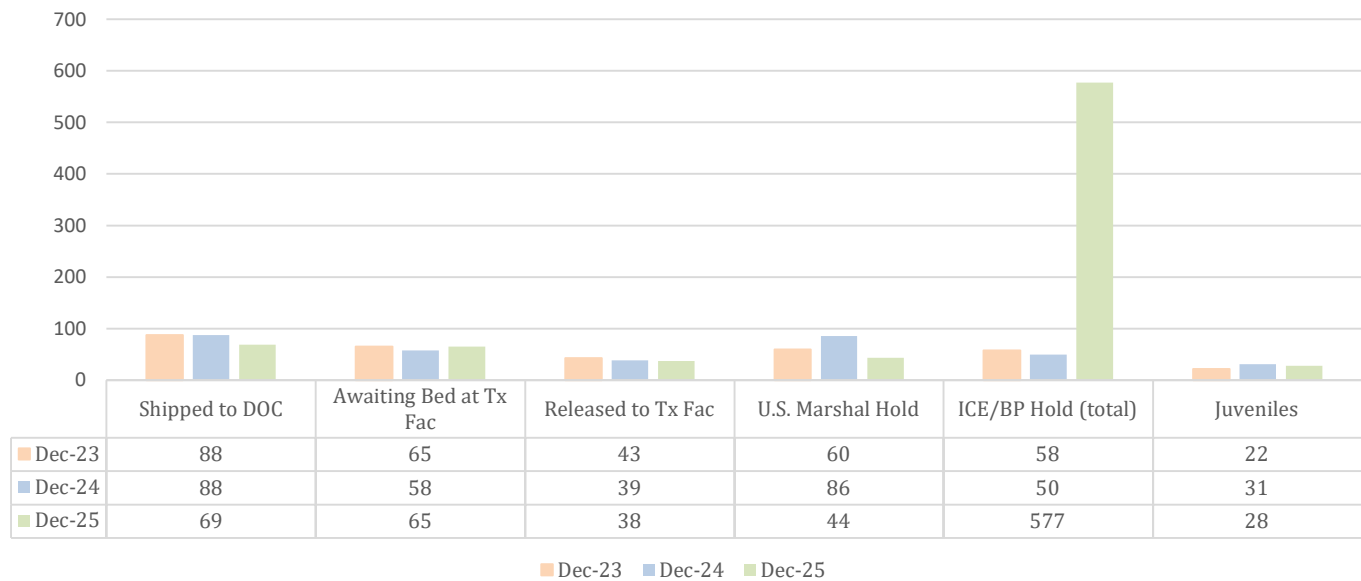

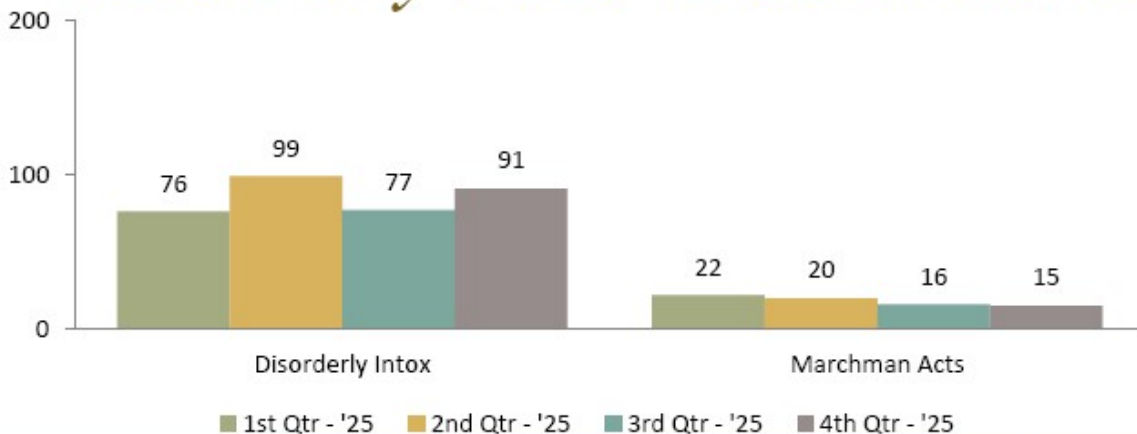
